### **Open Range Tournament Rules**

- 1) All Texas Parks and Wildlife regulations shall apply.
- 2) Only one rod may be used at a time. No trolling with a combustion engine. Only artificial baits may be used.
- 3) This is a 2 person team event, but you can fish alone if you do not have a fishing partner.
- 4) You must have a functioning livewell. Livewell checks will be done randomly and at the Tournament Director's discretion.
- 5) ½-lb penalty for dead fish.
- 6) Each team may weigh (5) five largemouth, smallmouth or Kentucky Spotted Bass. All fish must be 14 inches minimum length or it will not be weighed. YOU MUST BEGIN CULLING AFTER YOUR 6TH FISH IS BOATED. THIS MEANS CULL AS SOON AS THE 6TH FISH IS CAUGHT AND NOT AT THE RAMP or you will be disqualified. You may not cull dead fish.

- 7) Life jackets are required to be on anytime that your boat is above idle.
- 8) All prize winners are subject to a polygraph test. Polygraph testing will be performed at the discretion of the Tournament Director at any time. Anyone who is required to take a polygraph must pass the test before receiving any prizes. If a winner refuses to take a polygraph, he or she will be disqualified. Polygraph tests may or may not be administered the day of the tournament.
- 9) All ties will be broken by the weight of the largest fish for the team, if still tied we will flip a coin unless the teams agree to split the pot.
- 10) The use of alcohol and/or any non-prescription drugs during any of the tournament hours or at the weigh-in site will result in total team disqualification
- 11) Anyone leaving the lake early before the end of the tournament must contact the Tournament Director or any other member to let someone know that you are leaving early. This keeps us from searching in case of trouble while on the water.
- 12) By paying in you assume all responsibility and risks as personal and yours alone, and cannot hold anyone else associated with the tournament responsible in any way. It is, understood, that each individual is responsible for their own actions, and that the rest of the teams and the Tournament Director are not responsible for the actions or liability incurred by any individual angler.
- 13) The Tournament Director's decisions are final and not disputable.
